There is a great flying fox, archery, kayaks to paddle and swimming hole with a slide and rope swing amongst other attractions. Charges

All overnight charges include meals. Please note however that dinner on the Friday night is **not** included.

Children aged 3 years and under stay free.

The weekend runs from 7.30pm Friday until 3.00pm on Sunday.

The **full weekend** fee includes all meals from breakfast Saturday to lunch on Sunday.

There is no Saturday night only option available from the camp but please indicate if you are not intending to arrive until Saturday morning.

If you choose to come for the **day only** on Saturday the fee includes activities, lunch and dinner. Please indicate if there are any meals you will not be having so let the kitchen know how catering numbers.

Special Meals

Please indicate on the form if you need special meals e.g. vegetarian, gluten free, trim milk etc. Please indicate how many of these meals are needed at each meal your family attends. There is no extra charge.

Accommodation

Accommodation is in 20 cabins sleeping 4-6 people. There are in addition 4 dormitory rooms.

Separate boys and girls dorms will be available for older children (11+) / young adults.
